

YOUTH NATION DESTINY

Interview With Perry Jewell: Co-Founder Of Confederate Action Party

Mr. Perry Jewell is a legendary figure of the nationalist and patriotic opposition in Queensland. As a cofounder of the Confederate Action Party (1990), he acquired national prominence. We now ask Mr. Jewell his views on issues of the past and the present.

Audacity: The Confederate Action Party: how did it come into being? what motivated you to found it?

I returned from Africa in the early eighties to find that Australia had been even further internationalised since the Whitlam and Fraser years. It was evident to me that the bipartisan policy approach of both major political groupings (Lib-Nats and Lab-Dems-Greens) guaranteed that as long as the Australian people were prepared to accept the 'Claytons' Democracy of a compulsory vote, we would be locked into a 'no choice' system of government.

I met mainly transport operators, farmers, miners and engineers – if you like, a very good sample of the "doing / productive" type people – so essential to the Nation. Having these people as a sample meant there was an even greater disagreement with many of our compulsory elected Government's policies, both State and Federal.

Accordingly I drew up an abbreviated (A4 size) 38 policy statement and polled it past a few thousand people. To do this, I took a second job during the graveyard shift, 11pm – 7am, at a filling station. The polls were aggregate polls as few people had the time to consider all 38 policies. The final results were staggering: about 90% agreed with 90% of the policies, but did not fully understand some of the constitutional policies.

I came up with the fact that the sum total of all political parties membership was something less than 100,000 Nationwide. Put another way: Australia has about 8000 postcodes and a new party would only need to average 10 members per postcode to become the largest party (by membership) in Australia, both thought provoking and possible.

They say war is either a failure of, or a projection of, politics and that in simplistic terms the major difference is, in war it's bullets, in politics it's ballots; otherwise the two prerequisites are transport and communications. Where could a new party garner both of the latter – for free? Answer – the independent transport industry, and they helped this way. I was able to cover long distance at low cost, to speak, motivate and sign up new members and help generate the formation of CAP branches.

Despite being cold shouldered by the media, we achieved about 75 branches in Queensland with about 4000 members plus, about 25 branches in NSW and a few elsewhere.

Accordingly, I did all that I could to build a party to deliver a strong Nationalist nation and people. It seems that "White-Weak-Western" has betrayed us – perhaps we should go for "Strong-Staunch-Southern"?

Audacity: How do you rate its achievements and failures?

We showed that with virtually no media coverage, it was possible to spanner together a political party of several thousand members. This was in an age without the Internet. Up until then conventional thinking in Australia seemed to suggest that single issue parties were the way to go. CAP laid a very healthy foundation on which One Nation was able to build. Not so curiously, this was never mentioned by the media.

Failures: we believed that people would join the party to support it, not to destroy it.

Audacity: A welter of myth and misinformation circulated about your person. What impact did that have on Confederate Action Party? Was untruth 'organised'?

The various rumours may well have had damaging effects on CAP. I think that most people will accept that Australian politics are fundamentally "down there and dirty". I did not appreciate the scum that were threatening my family, targeting my 14 year old daughter in particular.

Some of the "untruth", as you put it, was organised. For example, letters were formulated alleging financial impropriety by the party hierarchy and mailed in by old age pensioners to "letters to the editor", in some major newspapers, later to be referred to in editorial comment.

Another example of slanderous misinformation was an ugly rumour that our National Executive had somehow borrowed or incurred a \$2,000,000 debt and was about to "shoot though overseas", and that as the CAP was not incorporated, the rank and file members were going to have to sell their assets to redeem the debt!

The rumours that I had been an MI5 mindbender and MI6 and CIA and even more unbelievably, a Ku Klux Klansman and a Mau Mau terrorist, could only have been credible to a raving lunatic.

Audacity: You witnessed the emergence, rise and fall of Hansonism? How do you understand and analyse this movement?

Hansonism was and is in the main, media orchestrated. Eventually, in my opinion, it was used to destroy or at least delay, the formation of a viable patriotic Nationalist party.

I don't doubt Mrs. Hanson's courage, but she never had the knowledge or the humility that will be needed to lead. When your ego exceeds your IQ, you have serious problems. There was never a master plan behind One Nation, just a reaction to the support and interest that was and still is, out there in "real Australia". Part of the team that helped destroy CAP seems to have been involved with the destabilisation and destruction of One Nation.

It I believe the word Hansonism is rn" used by the media to diminish Nawe tionalism in the mind of the public – ch-being easy to deride – by linking it personally to Mrs. Hanson each

time she is 'encouraged' to stand again, only to fail. Hansonism proved yet again that what the media create - they can also destroy.

Audacity: You are currently involved in the area of drug-law reform. Can you explain your approach to Australia's drug crisis?

"The largest single issue today in Australia is drug and alcohol abuse and nothing effective is being done about it". I am Founding President of Attack Dangerous Drugs, Injustice, Corruption Task Force (A.D.D.I.C.T) Association. We are formed to offer viable alternative policies and strategies to combat the drug and liquor debacle that is afflicting Australia. Maybe they see people as easier to control and manipulate if they are dumbed-down on illicit drugs, medically prescribed drugs and/or excessive alcohol consumption, totally switched off politics in their twilight world.

Back to A.D.D.IC.T. We believe that parental rights and authority must be restored. That drug and excessive liquor abuse should be compulsorily treated as and when detected with immediate detox and rehabilitation. Without either custodial sentences or fines. We should be constructing Sanitoriums for detox, rehab and mental health care rather than 'bigger and better jails' – more like Sweden perhaps. But we believe that much of the problem can be overcome at home.

We must have uniform National laws and enforcement to cripple and destroy drug abuse and a suitable ministry created at cabinet level.

An abbreviated agenda is shown on pages 67-70 in my book, *Drugs, Despair, Deliverance – Operation Osterley*.

Parents should be encouraged to grapple with the problem instead of being subjected to law, police and medical authorities. I believe that today in Australia there are millions of people who would back a viable anti drug initiative, as governments have failed them. It will fall to us parents and carers to force the action. When sufficient action is generated, they will either fall into line – or fall

Audacity: The drug crisis has affected you personally. What have you learned from that painful interlude?

Don't expect much or any help from the governments - State or Federal, the police, the courts or the church groups. They won't do your job for you. They have undermined parental rights and authority and have bluffed mass and individual parents into inaction. Much of the problem is political and legal. Criminality has flourished behind the shield of Government-inspired immigration and multiculturalism, legalised prostitution, casinos and gaming. The law seems to protect and advantage the criminal whilst disarming and legally emasculating the honest citizen.

The Nation will then go on to spend 6 times more per annum on the criminal than it will spend on an old age pensioner. From this I have



learnt if necessary to act alone guided by my own moral compass.

Audacity: Looking at the current Australian nationalist / patriotic scene, what lines of approach do you counsel?


Although none of us like political parties – the name of this game is party politics. Therefore to win – to take control of the political process we must build a bigger and better organised party than the internationalists.

We need to average 25 people in our 8000 postcodes at \$25.00 per annum Membership. To target assumption of government by 2025, ie. 25x25x8000. Once achieved = 200,000 members and a \$5,000,000 annual party budget.

To create a party such as this will require both discipline and dedication. The leaders must initially be prepared to work unpaid and to go both the distances in times and kilometres. Nationalists will often be served up as being the ultra right or even fascist – in a Nation whose media constantly misuse the word conservative when they should say liberal.

This plan will require speakers who can travel and motivate people to sign up as members and generate branch formation and action. So today in my opinion the time is ripe to build a genuinely Patriotic, Nationalist, Democratic party with Nationalist policies underwritten by the most truly Democratic policy of Citizens Initiated Referendum and Recall to be introduced from a position of Government.

The Australian government has adopted Garnaut's report as a new epistle of faith. They also deliberately miss the contradiction.

Yet, Dr. Graeme Pearman, a Monash University academic who specialises on climate issues, recently said: "The more people we have, the more land is needed; the more land that is needed to be cleared; the more water you need to capture from rivers and streams.." It matters not whether Dr. Pearman might be liberal on issues of ethnicity. It is a simple fact: the more featherless bipeds, the more unliveable Australia becomes. The Australian eastern coastal strip is already stressed; the inland is dying. These masses, huddled on the coast and its hinterland (particularly the eastern coast), will degrade it.

And Pearman has received the ultimate in academic support, when Professor Bob Birrell of Monash University weighed in. Professor Birrell warned in July that population in Australia must be brought under control and that immigration had already pushed Australia towards non sustainability.

Victorian Debate Yields Facts.

The soaring numbers have induced a crucial debate in August in Victoria. All States should listen.

Premier John Brumby has called to limit Australia's migrant intake, as Victoria struggles to cope with its population boom. But he would freeze it at the current level!! Victoria's population growth rate of 1.6% - or about 1500 people a week - was above the national

growth average. "Five years ago, I think the number of migrants coming to Australia was about 100,000 a year. This year it will hit 200,000 a year," Mr Brumby told ABC radio in early August. "I'd say that number is about right. We wouldn't, at this point in time in our history, be wanting to go above that."

As director of Monash University's Centre for Population and Urban Research, Bob Birrell, said most previous premiers had seen the health of the Victorian economy as intimately linked to population growth because of its obvious impact on housing, infrastructure and other industries. It meant big profits for the traitor class.

But Prof Birrell said the 1.6% growth the State was experiencing was too much, and "1.6 is what got us here". Prof. Birrell, argued this means an overcrowded State with too much pressure on water, infrastructure and housing.

Naturally, the Committee for Melbourne chief executive Sally Capp said Melbourne still needed skilled migrants to help its economy, but she even conceded it could only handle as many as its amenities allowed. However, Victorian Chamber of Commerce and Industry chief economist Steven Wojkiw, said all things being equal, more people would help the state economy." That was truly expected.

Australia's 2008-09 Migration Program has 190,300 places, an increase of almost 20% on the previous year. The so-called Humanitarian Program ('refugees') has some 13,500 places.

According to the national Bureau of

Statistics, Victoria grew by 82,430 in 2007. More than half of that growth - 49,006 people - came from overseas, while 36,513 came from "natural increase". This inevitably means a *de-nativisation of the population*. This trend is Australia wide. This impacts on the survival of Australian cultural forms.

Over-development And Water

The city of Greater Sydney cannot sustain the 4.3 million persons who inhabit it. Yet, the plan of the New South Wales government is to raise that to 6,000,000 by 2030. Hence we see the desalination plant at Kurnell – now a target of Australia First protest. One goal seems to be to create one massive conurbation of about eight millions stretching from Wollongong to Port Stephens. This 'model' is a little like the veritable single city that now runs almost from Tweed Heads to Brisbane to the Sunshine Coast!

All this is madness. The demands for water will destroy the ecosystem. Interestingly, the New South Wales Planning Minister, Frank Sartor, is currently pushing for a massive one hundred thousand increase in population on the Central Coast. Already, houses are being built on water catchments (!) and close to beach areas not much above sea level. Mangrove is being drained. It will also implode lifestyle and turn Gosford into another dead CBD-type city 'serving' the Central Coast with the culturaldesert products of Sydney's cosmopolitan-capitalism.

Radical Solutions.... Not Globalist Propaganda!

The nationalists are rational radicals. We want fundamental solutions. The simplest and most immediate demand is for a long time freeze upon immigration. This could later be followed by zero net immigration: one person leaves permanently, one person comes. Many farmers could be employed to reinvigorate their land rather than grow export crops. Some development projects should be scrapped. Coastal tourism and housing development could be quashed! Some water could be piped from northern Australia to flush the dying Murray-Darling system. And so on!

All this means stepping outside of the free-for-all economic doctrine and the politics which serve it. It could only be done by a nationalist government with the will to act.

The Nationalists Make It 'Local'



Australia First Builds Towards Federal Registration, Strong Bonds Formed With NZ Nationalists

Australia First Party moves towards being a Federal registered party. This goal will be effectively achieved when the application to register is made later this year. As we go to press, members are being drawn in progressively from former parties of nationalism and patriotism, providing the party with experienced cadre for future expansion. Members continue to join directly from the public.

The Australia First Party has set out a number of broad strategic lines of approach. The party seeks to mobilise *Real Australia*, not the mainstream, those members of productive Australia, the workers, farmers, small business and other patriotic working people, who are prepared to stand up against the globalist system and who will step outside of mainstream meth-

-ods and political forms.

Electorally, this approach signifies the attempt to re-group a voting bloc from available sectors of the target groups – and certain interest groups as well, including some environmentalists, shooters, ex One Nation voters.

The party's national conference in June 2008 was attended by a delegation of the New Zealand Nationalist Alliance (NZNA). Messrs. Anton Folambje and Steve Larsen addressed the conference on the issues and history of the Kiwi nationalist experience. They spoke openly in solidarity with Australia First.

As a result of the meeting with the Kiwi nationalists, an ANZAC Manifes-

festo was drafted and published. This Manifesto, available on the Internet, lays out the basis of common ideological and political principle, building upon the ANZAC Declaration of April 25.

The New Zealand party has invited members of Australia First to form a delegation to attend its Flag Day rally in Wellington in October.

The growing links between the Australian and New Zealand nationalists have extended to the use of the excellent Kiwi book-service, Renaissance Press by Australians, the publication of a crucial NZ text on the coming war between Russia and China on our website and the use of Australian material on the Kiwi website.

The fraternal bonds between our parties has been noted by the far-left Trotskyite and anarchist groups who have threatened violence against the Flag Day and the participating Australians.

Like Australia First, he NZNA also seeks to become a registered party in New Zealand.

The discussions at the national conference and the private meetings with the Kiwi delegates have invigorated the leadership of Australia First to raise the party's profile and to achieve its strategic goals. The party has a sense of urgency and refuses to allow itself to be sidetracked or disrupted. While being cooperative with all patriotic people, we must build this party!

The Eight Core Policies Of Australia First: A Programme And A Method

Whatever will benefit Australia, that we are for; whatever will harm Australia, that we are against. William Lane

²The core policies of Australia First are the basis of association of the party. They are (with explanations) as follows:

1 Ensure Australia Retains Full Independence

Protect our sovereignty (national, constitutional and personal) and maintain an adequate defence whilst being compassionate and fair in our nation's international dealings.

2 Rebuild Australian Manufacturing Industries

This is the only way we can be self sufficient. It will provide jobs for our children, and help buy back the farm and allow Australia to be free of foreign debts. Our infrastructure has been run down over many years - it must be rebuilt. We must improve the practicality and relevance of our educational systems, and target government support for industry to diversify, innovate, perform and expand. We recognise that small business is fundamental to this policy. A satisfactory financial environment is also essential.

3 Control Foreign Ownership

Bring foreign ownership and investment back under control.

4 Reduce and Limit Immigration

Immigration mistakes can be big long term mistakes. Immigration policy must take into account social cohesion, employment opportunities, urbanisation and environmental issues

5 Abolish Multiculturalism

End the divisive, government funded and institutionalised policy of multiculturalism.

6 Introduce Citizen's Initiated Referenda

Amend the Australian Constitution so that the people can initiate constitutional referendums which, if approved by the Australian people, will amend the Australian Constitution. This simple step will confirm the political authority of voters and make politicians aware that they are the servants of the Australian People,

not their masters.

7. Strengthen the family

Promote policies that strengthen and protect the traditional family.

8 Strive to Rebuild A United Australia

Promote policies that recognise the interdependence of city and country.

The party rules also imply a point nine.

9 Democratise Other Policy Issues

All other policies (non-core policies) are matters of free conscience and are not binding upon Australia First's future parliamentarians or councillors who are to represent their electorates.

Issues of public interest on which Australia First needs to formulate policy will be canvassed with the party membership and plebiscites conducted where deemed appropriate by the party's National Council. The party also permits branches to formulate specific electoral policies or community policies not inconsistent with the Eight Core Policies.

From time to time, the party will issue material that provides interpretation of the core policies. This interpretative material would reflect the spirit of the party.

The organizational purpose for this statement of policy and system for policy creation is simple: Australia First does not require weighty tomes, which change from month to month, as do the programmes of the Establishment parties and those who ape them. It requires a focus for action and for unity within the party.

Australia First is to build a new national movement. Practicality is method.
